SABINA, J

Petitioner has filed this petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ in the nature of Certiorari for quashing the letter/order dated 10.02.2016 (Annexure P-10).

The case of the petitioner, in brief, is that the petitioner had applied for the job of Sailor advertised by the respondents. Petitioner cleared the written test as well as physical fitness test. However, when the petitioner was medically examined, he was declared unfit vide Annexure P-10 on the ground that he was suffering from Hypertension.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has been declared medically unfit on irrelevant consideration. In fact, the petitioner was medically fit.

In the present case, although, petitioner had cleared the written test as well as physical fitness test, but when he was medically examined, it was found that he was suffering from Hypertension and consequently, he was declared unfit for enrollment in the Navy due to Hypertension vide Annexure P-10.

Since the petitioner was not found medically fit for enrollment as Sailor in the Navy, no ground for interference by this Court while exercising jurisdiction under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, is made out.

Dismissed.
