Feeling aggrieved against the alleged in-action on the part of the respondent authorities, petitioner has approached this Court by way of instant writ petition under Article 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ in the nature of mandamus.

Notice of motion was issued, however, no reply has been filed either on behalf of the official respondents or on behalf of the contesting respondent no.4.

After going through the averments taken in the writ petition and hearing the learned counsel for respondents, present writ petition is disposed off with a direction to the Saraswati Kunj Cooperative House Building

Administrator to look into the matter, consider the grievance raised by the petitioner vide her representation dated 22.09.2015 (Annexure P5) and decide the same at an early date by passing an order strictly in accordance with law but in any case within a period of three months.

With the above said observations made and directions issued, present writ petition is disposed off.
