1. This petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ of certiorari quashing the letters dated 22.03.2016 (Annexure P-13 & Annexure P-14) whereby respondents No. 2 and 3 have directed respondent No. 4 to freeze the account of the petitioner and further a writ of mandamus directing respondent No. 3 and respondent No. 4 to immediately defreeze the bank accounts of the petitioner bearing Nos. 65226407518, 6518110990 and 65226337810

2. After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner states that he may be allowed to withdraw the petition with liberty to the petitioner to file a comprehensive representation raising the issue as sought to be raised in the present petition before the respondents within two days.

However, a prayer was made that directions be issued to the respondents to decide the same expeditiously.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn. However, it is observed that the petitioner would be at liberty to file a comprehensive representation before the respondents raising its grievance within a week from today. In case such representation is filed by the petitioner before the respondents within the stipulated period, the same shall be decided by the concerned Authority within next one week of its filing by passing a speaking order and after affording an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner in accordance with law.
