This petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent No. 2 to attest the Surety Bond (Annexure P-4) dated 21.03.2016 submitted by the petitioner and also for directions to respondent No. 3 to release the goods on furnishing of such Surety Bond as prescribed under Section 51(6)(a) of the Punjab VAT Act, 2005.

2. Learned State counsel submitted that during the pendency of the petition the Surety Bond has been attested and goods have been released by the respondents to the petitioner against bank guarantee. It was urged that this petition has become infructuous and may be disposed of as well. Learned counsel for the petitioner has not controverted the abovesaid statement made by learned State counsel.

3. Ordered accordingly.
