This petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the orders dated 06.05.2013 and 28.03.2014 (Annexure P-3 & Annexure P-4 respectively) and for directions to respondent No. 6 to entertain Tax Invoices, C-4 Certificates and & declaration forms and allow statutory benefits for the assessment year 2007-08.

2. On perusal of the petition, it seems that there is some mistake in the head note and prayer clause of the petition. There is mention of respondent No. 6 in the petition whereas there is no such respondent in the memo of parties. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that he may be allowed to withdraw the petition with liberty to file a fresh one on the same cause of action with better particulars.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.
