Instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari quashing the award dated 11.6.2015 (Annexure P/1) passed by respondent no.1 – Permanent Lok Adalat, Public Utility Services, Narnaul and further prayer for mandamus directing respondent nos.2 and 3 to make the payment of the claim of Rs.3,09,080/- along with interest to the petitioner.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and perused the record.

The Permanent Lok Adalat, after considering the evidence on record, came to the conclusion that there is no specific registration number is mentioned. However, vehicle was insured vide policy No. 102017/31/12/006952 with regard to Engine No. 11K63195894 and Chasis No. N21304. Perusal of registration certificate (Ex.R/11) shows that Engine No. 11J84021653 and Chasis No. MAT 448050BOK18072 mentioned therein do not relate to that policy.

In view of above, claim of the petitioner has rightly been rejected by the Permanent Lok Adalat.

Dismissed.
