Feeling aggrieved against the sanction of wrong mutation No.72820 (Annexure P-2), petitioner has approached this Court by way of present writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ in the nature of mandamus.

Notice of motion was issued and in compliance thereof, short reply by way of affidavit dated 04.07.2016 of Naib Tehsildar, Moga was filed, admitting therein that mutation No.72820 was wrongly entered and sanctioned. This mutation was directed to be corrected, however, again mutation No.73436 was wrongly recorded, which is under consideration of the competent authority for its rectification.

Learned counsel for the State, while referring to para 3 of the affidavit dated 04.07.2016, submits that competent authority is already seized of the matter and needful shall be done within a period of six weeks from today.

In view of the abovesaid undisputed fact situation obtaining on record of the present case, instant writ petition is disposed of, with a direction to Deputy Commissioner, Moga-respondent No.2 to look into the matter and ensure that wrongly recorded mutation No.73436 dated 22.06.2016 is corrected without any further loss of time and a correct mutation is entered and sanctioned in favour of the person entitled for the same. Let the needful be done at an early date and in any case within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

With the abovesaid observations made and directions issued, present writ petition stands disposed of.
