SABINA, J.

Petitioner has filed this petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the respondents to decide the representation of the petitioner for correct pay fixation of pay and financial benefits accruing under the Assured Career Progression Scheme, 1999.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that petitioner had moved representation (Annexure P-5) to the respondents for redressal of his grievance but no action has been taken on the same so far.

Accordingly, without adverting to the merits of the case, this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to dispose of the representation Annexure P-5 expeditiously, in accordance with law, preferably within two months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.
