The petitioners seek an extension of time to pay the amounts as per order dated 12.12.2015 passed by the Debts Recovery Tribunal (Annexure P.2). The petitioners had made an application to the Debts Recovery Tribunal but withdrew the same stating that they wanted to pursue some other independent remedy and did not want to proceed with the same. The petitioners' remedy, if any, is in fact to make an application for extension of time before the Debts Recovery Tribunal itself which had passed the initial order dated 12.12.2015. The petition is, therefore, disposed of with liberty to the petitioners to move an application for revival of the earlier application or to file fresh application.
