Learned counsel for the petitioners does not press the present petition qua petitioner No.4.

Petitioners No.1 to 3 on attaining the age of superannuation retired as Librarians from the Department of Higher Education, Government of Haryana. Through the present petition they seek issuance of directions to the respondents to grant them the benefit of fixation of pension not less than of 50% of the corresponding pay scale of Rs.37400-67000+9000 GP w.e.f 01.01.2006.

Today Mr. Harish Rathee, Sr. DAG, Haryana has produced an order dated 30.03.2016 through which the relief as claimed in the present petition qua petitioner No.1 Gopal Krishan Lal has been granted. Copy of the same has been handed over to the learned counsel for the petitioner who after going through the same expresses satisfaction qua the claim of petitioner No.1-Gopal Krishan Lal.

Mr. Harish Rathee, Sr. DAG, Haryana on instructions from Mr. Raj Singh, Assistant, in the office of Director Education, Haryana submits that so far as petitioner Nos. 2 & 3 are concerned, their cases qua the relief claimed by them in the present petition have been sent for approval to the Finance Department, Government of Haryana, which is expected within 10 days from today. He further submits that on the receipt of such approval necessary orders in case of petitioner Nos. 2 & 3 for the relief claimed by them in the present petition would be passed.

On the basis of the aforementioned order dated 30.03.2016 and the afore referred statement made on behalf of State of Haryana learned counsel for the petitioner states that the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

Ordered accordingly.
