The petitioner seeks direction for grant for regular joint time table on Gurdaspur-Talwara via Mukerian route instead of the provisional time table, which is in operation since 30.12.2010 (Annexure P-2).

It is the case of the petitioner that he had also filed a representation on 08.09.2015 (Annexure P-3) with the respondent for the necessary relief for providing regular time table on this route. Resultantly, the present writ petition has been filed, on account of the inaction of the respondent.

In the reply filed by the respondent, it has been averred that the petitioner has never moved the said representation and as and when the representation is received the order will be passed in accordance with law.

Counsel for the petitioner states that similar application now has also been filed on 21.09.2016 (wrongly mentioned as 21.09.2015). A photocopy of the same has been taken on record. It has further been submitted that it was diarized vide Diary No.16656 on 21.9.2016 with the respondent.

Keeping in view the stand of the respondent, the present writ petition is, accordingly, disposed of with the direction to the respondent to decide the grouse of the petitioner, which has now also been addressed by filing an application, vide the above diary number.

Needful be done within a period of two months from the receipt of the certified copy of this order.

With the above observations, the present writ petition stands disposed of.
