In view thereof, the present petition is hereby disposed of with liberty to the petitioners to raise all the objections as available to them before the election committee on 2.5.2016 which shall be decided by the election committee within two days thereafter i.e. by 5.5.2016 after giving personal hearing to the representative of the parties and by passing a speaking order.

Needless to mention that in case, the petitioners remain dissatisfied with the order of the election committee they would still have the remedy to approach this Court again. Till then the election process shall remain stayed.
