The instant petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing respondents No. 1 to consider the application dated 21.03.2016 (Annexure P-5) moved by the petitioner and grant permission to celebrate Baisakhi Mela on 13.04.2016 at village Jhander Kalan.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and perused the record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner vehemently contends that this Mela is being held since times immemorial at the place and the petitioner has moved application dated 21.03.2016 (Annexure P-5) for grant of permission to celebrate the Baisakhi Mela on 13.04.2016 to the Deputy Commissioner, Saheed Bhagat Singh Nagar.

On specific question put to the learned counsel for the petitioner as to whether the Action Committee is registered one or not, the counsel candidly admitted that there are two groups who intend to celebrate the Baisakhi Mela at that place. The application Annexure P-5 also does not mention about the place where the Baisakhi mela is intended to be celebrated.

In these circumstances, no relief can be granted to the petitioner.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to file fresh application before respondent No.1- the Deputy Commissioner-cum-District Magistrate, Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid. If such an application is filed before respondent No. 1, the same shall be considered and decided in accordance with law.
