Through the present petition, the petitioner seeks quashing of order dated 05.11.2015 (Annexure P-6), passed by the District Program Officer, Women and Child Development, Ambala, through which her services as an Anganwadi Worker have been dispensed with.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner and perusing the record with his able assistance, the facts that have emerged, are that from the year 2009, the petitioner has been repeatedly asked to improve her performance but to no avail. She has also been issued several warnings but despite the same, the petitioner's performance/behaviour showed no improvement.

The petitioner had also kept official record with her without any authorisation and had been found to be willfully absent from her duties without any permission from the competent authority since May,

2011.

In view of the aforesaid repeated acts of omission and commission on her part, she was issued a show cause notice, in response of which she filed a reply. She was also granted an opportunity of hearing. After considering her reply and the submissions made by her at the time of personal hearing, finding her to be incompetent person in the discharge of her duties and on account of the fact that she had been unauthorisedly absent since May, 2011, her services have been dispensed with through the order impugned in the present petition.

The petitioner's work and conduct having been found to be persistently bad, the petitioner being unauthorisedly absent from her duties since May, 2011 and in spite of having been issued several warnings, having not improved her work and conduct, she does not deserve any relief.

Dismissed.
