The petitioner has challenged the eligibility of respondent No.5- a private party to participate in the tender. The petitioner contends that clause 25 of the terms and conditions of the NIT required a list of the members of the society duly attested by Cooperative Department to be uploaded alongwith identity proofs of the members of society. The petitioner states that respondent No.5 has failed to comply with this condition and that this condition is mandatory. The basis of the information is not disclosed. This fact has not even been brought to the notice of the official respondents who have invited tenders.

2. The petitioner in the first instance ought to invite the attention of the official respondents in this regard. In the event of the petitioner addressing his grievances/allegations in writing against respondent No.5 to the official respondents by 18.04.2016, the official respondents shall take a decision to allot the work only after considering the same and informing the petitioner of the same in writing.

The petition is disposed of with the liberty as aforesaid.
