The petitioner is seeking to quash the order dated 03.03.2016 (Annexure P-5), whereby No Objection Certificate (NOC) for higher studies has not been issued to him.

Director General Health Services-respondent No.2 has refused to issue NOC to the petitioner on the ground that period of punishment, whereby his increments had been stopped, had not expired.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that by taking a lenient view, the petitioner should have been granted NOC to enable him to pursue his higher studies as this the last chance available to him.

At this stage, this petition is disposed of by giving a direction to respondent No.1 to consider the case of the petitioner and pass appropriate order in accordance with law, within a period of four weeks
