S.J.VAZIFDAR, ACTING CHIEF JUSTICE (ORAL):

The petitioner claims the allotment of a plot under the oustees quota. There appears to be a dispute, at least, as regards a part of the property. According to the petitioner, there is a dispute only in respect of 04 kanals out of the total area of 16 kanals. Learned counsel for the respondents state that they have been repeatedly seeking information from the petitioner but the same has not been furnished.

The ends of justice would be met by disposing of the petition with the following order:

The respondents shall inform the petitioner, in writing,
the information that they require. The petitioner shall furnish the

same if possible. The respondents agree to pass a fresh order on the application for allotment under the oustees quota after considering the same in accordance with law.
