The petition has been filed seeking direction to the Debts Recovery Tribunal-I & The Recovery Officer-II, Debts Recovery Tribunal-II, Chandigarh (respondents No.1 and 2) to finally decide the pending objections dated 02.09.2015 (Annexure P-5) against the attachment order dated 19.03.2014 (Annexure P-4) at an early date in a time bound manner.
