RITU BAHRI, J.

The petitioner, by way of present petition, is seeking direction to the respondents to make payment of gratuity for the services rendered with them w.e.f. 1981 to 1994.

Upon notice, written statement on behalf of respondent No.3 has been filed. In preliminary objections, explanation has been given to the effect that as per communication received from respondent No.2, last salary drawn by the petitioner was Rs.18,330/- and his date of retirement was 30.06.2009. The last salary drawn by Gurbhajan Singh was Rs.20,040/- and his date of retirement was 31.07.2011. The gratuity has been calculated on the basis of communication supplied by respondent No.2. The aforesaid Gurbhajan Singh retired after more than two years from the retirement of the

petitioner, therefore, his basic salary was more than the petitioner. The petitioner cannot claim parity with Gurbhajan Singh with regard to amount of gratuity.

After going through the reply filed, the amount paid to Gurbhajan Singh has been duly explained by the respondents. Therefore, no further orders are required to be passed in this petition.

Dismissed.
