Instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari quashing the order dated 22.06.2010 (Annexure P-5) passed by respondent No.4 whereby *Naksha Zeem* was approved, the order dated 17.08.2010 (Annexure P-7) passed by respondent No.4, the order dated 25.04.2011 (Annexure P-10) passed by respondent No.3, the order dated 07.08.2012 (Annexure P-12) passed by respondent No.2 and the order

dated 08.07.2014 (Annexure P-14) passed by respondent No.1.

Vide order dated 16.05.2016, Assistant Collector-IIInd Grade was directed to prepare fresh *Naksha Bey* along with *khataunis* and field book as per shares of the parties and if the passage is already existing, then the area should be partitioned in such a manner that area of each party should touch the passage already existing.

In pursuance of the order dated 16.05.2016, Mr. Rupinder Singh, Assistant Collector IInd Grade has produced amended *Naksha Bey* and states that deficiency of one kanal has been made good. *Naksha Bey* has been shown to learned counsel for the parties which is acceptable to them. The same is taken on record as Ex.C1.

In view of above, Assistant Collector-IIInd Grade is directed to approve *Naksha Bey* (Ex.C-1) on record and thereafter get *Naksha Zeem* prepared and proceed in accordance with law. Needful shall be done within two months from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
