Instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of direction to the respondents not to carve out any watercourse in the land of petitioner comprised in rect. No.192, killa No.9/1, 8/1, 7/2, situated in the area of village Lakhewali Mustil/Kabul Shah Khubban, Tehsil and District Fazilka.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and perused the record.

Vide order dated 08.10.2015 (Annexure P-3), the Superintending Canal Officer ordered restoration of watercourse running on the joint boundary of the land comprised in rect. No.192, killa No.9/1,

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8/1, 7/2 and 9/2, 8/2, 7/3. This Court has no doubt that the canal authorities shall restore the watercourse running on the khasra numbers as mentioned in the order dated 08.10.2015, not any other.

In view of above, instant petition is dismissed with the aforesaid observations.
