To plead unfair discrimination, neither the names of the similarly situated persons against whom the case is set up have been mentioned nor in Para.6 of the petition where only bald and general assertions have been made without the juniors being named. In absence of names of persons, who were regularized and the petitioners ignored, the petitioners are relegated to their alternative remedy before the industrial adjudicator, where facts can be pleaded or proved on evidence.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of by relegating the petitioners to their alternative remedy.
