Petitioner approached this Court seeking a direction to release the payment for the organic manure supplied by him.

In the reply, stand taken by the respondents is that no quotations were called; no written orders were placed; the competent authority did not receive any tender and no resolution for payment was passed.

Considering the reply filed, where basic facts have been disputed, the writ petition filed by the petitioner claiming the payment of money for the organic manure supplied by him is dismissed. However, the petitioner shall be at liberty to avail of any appropriate remedy, in accordance with law.
