S.J.VAZIFDAR, ACTING CHIEF JUSTICE (ORAL):

A Division Bench of this Court, by an order dated
28.01.2016, inter alia, ordered as follows:

not be allowed to run at the present site from
01.04.2016 and the Deputy Commissioner, Mohali is
directed to file his affidavit in compliance in advance
on the date fixed along with the details of proposed
new locations.***

indicating the compliance of the order and the same is taken on record.
