Instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari quashing the order dated 01.04.2016 (Annexure P-6) whereby eviction order of quarter No.B-013 has been passed and further the order dated 18.04.2016 (Annexure P-7) whereby interim prayer for stay of eviction has been declined.

Vide order dated 26.04.2016, notice of motion was issued

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and petitioner was directed to file affidavit as to whether he is ready to vacate the premises after a reasonable time.

In pursuance of the order dated 26.04.2016, affidavit dated 11.05.2016 has been filed by the petitioner to the effect that he is ready to vacate the premises, if one year time is granted to him. The petitioner also undertakes that he will withdraw the appeal pending before learned Additional District Judge, Karnal. The said affidavit dated 11.05.2016 is taken on record.

Although, the petitioner has sought one year time for vacation of the premises, but this Court deems it fit that approximately four months' time i.e. upto 30.09.2016 be provided to the petitioner. The petitioner will pay all the arrears of rent within one week from today and will also deposit the rent upto 30.09.2016, within one month, at the rate which the petitioner is already paying. The petitioner, as agreed, will also withdraw the appeal pending in the Court of learned Addl. District Judge, Karnal. If the petitioner does not vacate the quarter/accommodation/premises within the stipulated period by 30.09.2016, the respondents will be at liberty to evict the petitioner with police help and without any further notice. It will be the duty of the petitioner that he should hand over the vacant possession of the premises by 30.09.2016 before 4.30 P.M. to the concerned authority.
