The petitioner is claiming benefit of Section 24 (2) of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 (for short 'the Act') by way of filing this petition under Article 226 of Constitution of India.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that inadvertently certain documents showing the physical possession of the property as on date, could not be appended alongwith the writ petition and prays that he may be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to file a fresh one on the same cause of action by appending relevant documents showing the physical possession of the petitioner as on date so as to entitle her to claim benefit of Section 24(2) of the Act.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.
