The writ petition has been filed by the petitioner for directing Municipal Corporation, Moga and Deputy Commissioner, Moga (respondents No. 2 and 3) for initiating proceedings under Sections 269-272 of the Punjab Municipal Corporation Act, 1976 in respect of three storeyed commercial complex constructed at Main Bazaar, Near Sarafa Bazaar, Moga, which, it is alleged, have been constructed in violation of the building bye-laws in connivance with the officials of the Municipal Corporation, Moga (respondent No.2).

On the last date of hearing, i.e. 05.05.2016, it was observed that the petitioner in his affidavit dated 09.04.2016 had submitted that he was a social worker. Learned counsel for the petitioner had taken time to show the nature of social work that had been conducted by the petitioner.

When the case is taken up today, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be allowed to withdraw the writ petition so

as to avail other remedies in accordance with law.

The petitioner is permitted to withdraw the present petition so as to enable him to avail other remedies in accordance with law.
