The only grievance of the petitioner in the present writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is against the notification No.R-30015/4/2015-MC dated 21.01.2015 (Annexure P-7) issued by respondent No.3-Ministry of Petroleum and Natural Gas, Govt. of India because of which L.O.I. (letter of intent) is not being issued.

Learned Addl. Solicitor General of India and learned

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counsel for respondent-Bharat Petroleum Corporation Limited (for brevity, 'B.P.C.L.') state that the aforesaid notification has been withdrawn by the Ministry of Petroleum and Natural Gas, Govt. of India vide letter dated 25.02.2016.

In view of above, instant petition has become infructuous.

Dismissed as infructuous.

However, respondent No.1-B.P.C.L. will be at liberty to proceed in accordance with law.
