Petitioner has approached this Court under Articles 226/227 of
Constitution of India seeking a writ in the nature of Certiorari for setting
aside the impugned order dated 18.03.2016 (Annexure P-1) passed by
DRAT, Delhi and also the impugned order dated 21.03.2016 (Annexure
P-2) passed by the learned DRT-I, Chandigarh under the Securitization
and Reconstruction of the Financial Assets and Enforcement of Security
Interest Act, 2002.

2. Learned counsel for the respondents submitted that during the

pendency of the writ petition the DRT-I, Chandigarh has passed the final order on 20.10.2016. Therefore, in view thereof this writ petition has been rendered infructuous and be disposed of as such. The said fact has not been controverted by the learned counsel for the petitioner.

4. However, it shall be open to the petitioner to take recourse to the remedies for redressal of its grievance as may be available to it in accordance with law.
