The petitioner seeks migration to the respondent No.3-institute from the Regional Centre-respondent No.1, where he is pursuing the 5 Year L.L.B. Course. He had applied for migration when he was in the 3rd semester and he had filed the present writ petition when he was in the 4th semester.

It is not disputed that the list of candidates who had applied for migration had been prepared by the respondent No.3-institute. The petitioner was at waiting list No.1, on the strength of the merit. Against the six vacancies, the persons mentioned at Sr. No.1 to 6 (Annexure P-2) consumed the vacancies. Thus, it is the stand of the respondent-University that there are no vacant seat.

Initially, there was a dispute qua one candidate, namely, Divya Jandwani who had filed **CWP No.5736 of 2016**, which had been dismissed on 29.03.2016. Subsequently, the Division Bench in **LPA No.507 of 2016**, decided on 22.07.2016 directed grant of no objection to the said candidate. It is the case of the respondent-University that she has been granted migration, accordingly. Thus, there are no vacancies available.

The petitioner has also now been promoted to the 5th semester. It is not disputed that candidates can apply in the said semester also, in case there is any vacancy. It will be open to the petitioner to apply against the vacancy, if any available or as and when notified.

Accordingly, no relief can be granted to the petitioner. With the abovesaid observations, the present writ petition stands disposed of.
