This Order shall dispose of 11 writ petitions bearing CWP Nos. 8558, 8555, 9700, 9754, 17238, 6377 of 2015 and 8564 of 2014 in which the petitioners are the Educational Institutes and with petitions bearing CWP Nos. 22626, 27075 of 2015 and 4707, 4712 of 2016 in which the petitioners are the students, who have prayed for a direction to the respondents to release the due

amount under the Scheme of SCD-V Post-Matric Scholarship Schemes for Scheduled Caste Students.

On the last date of hearing i.e. 14.03.2016, Kripa Shankar Saroj, Secretary, Punjab Government, Welfare Department, Chandigarh was directed to file an affidavit and also to remain present in Court.

Today, Affidavit dated 22.03.2016 sworn by Kripa Shankar Saroj, Secretary, Punjab Government, Welfare Department, Chandigarh is filed today in Court and is present in Court. He has stated at the bar and also averred in the affidavit that the petitioners would be paid 100% of their dues within a month i.e. Upto 22.04.2016.
