S.J.VAZIFDAR, ACTING CHIEF JUSTICE (ORAL):

The Appellate Authority has not pronounced the order regarding the petitioner's eligibility to be allotted a plot in the New Anaj Mandi on account of Old Sabji Mandi, from which he operated, having been de-notified.

The open auction is scheduled to be held tomorrow i.e.20.01.2016. Appeal of the petitioner is also pending. It is necessary to protect the rights of the petitioner.

In the circumstances, the petition is disposed of, with the following order:

The auction may proceed except in respect of one plot, to be identified by the respondents, which shall be reserved for the petitioner in the event of his succeeding. The rights of the petitioner and the respondents

shall be decided in accordance with the final order to be passed by the Appellate Authority, subject, of course, to any challenge thereto.
