On 25.04.2016, on behalf of the appellants statement was made to accept ₹2,00,000/- over and above the amount already awarded by the Tribunal in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. Today, on behalf of respondent No.2 – RSRTC concurrence has been given to this effect. Thus, a sum of ₹2,00,000/- (₹ Two Lac Only) is allowed to the appellants against respondent No.2 – RSRTC. As per the statement of learned counsel for the appellants, the enhanced amount be paid to appellant No.1 – Yadvender son of Dhoop Singh.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to respondent No.2 - RSRTC to deposit a crossed – cheque for ₹2,00,000/- in the name of appellant No.1 - Yadvender son of Dhoop Singh with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 29.08.2016, in compliance of this order, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The concerned Officer of the Lok Adalat Branch/Office shall issue proper receipt after receiving the cheque to learned counsel/representative of respondent No.2 – RSRTC. The appellant(s)' counsel/appellant(s) may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Copy of the order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the Hon'ble High Court.
