1.) The firm of the petitioner, namely, M.P. Enterprises was a tenant in Shop No.12 near Ghanta Ghar, Harmandar Sahib, Amritsar. The area where the shop was located is now part of the 'Galiara Project' undertaken by the Shiromani Gurdwara Parbandhak Committee (for short 'SGPC') for beautification, widening and expansion of Shri Harmandar Sahib Complex. Though such an exercise was undertaken by SGPC, yet the Amritsar Development Authority has come forward with a rehabilitation policy and consequently, the petitioner has been offered shop No.13 in the newly constructed Plaza by the Amritsar Development Authority. The

petitioner's grievance is that the said shop is not in the Plaza and is located outside. The shop is still under construction. In our considered view, the petitioner cannot seek a shop of her choice as a matter of right as all the uprooted tenants like her have been allotted shops by way of draw of lots. However, if she is not satisfied with the allotment of the said shop and if any fresh draw of lots is held in future, let the claim of the petitioner be also sympathetically re-considered subject to her undertaking to comply with condition No.2 of the allotment letter.
