Appellant is present along with his counsel. In the order passed by us on 31.03.2016, we made it very clear that if the appellant did not bring demand draft towards arrears of maintenance, the appeal would be dismissed.

Learned counsel for the respondent on instructions informs the Court that the appellant is liable to pay more than ₹1,60,000/- towards arrears of maintenance in terms of order passed on 24.05.2013. Infact, the order passed on 24.05.2013 would read that the appellant shall pay the maintenance on 7th of every calender month.

Appellant has not brought any demand draft towards arrears of maintenance.

Therefore, the appeal stands dismissed for non-prosecution.
