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**S.J.VAZIFDAR, ACTING CHIEF JUSTICE (ORAL):**

The petitioners have challenged the decision of the official respondents namely respondents No.1 to 5 to consider the bid of the private respondent i.e.respondent No.6

The petitioners contend that after the tender process commenced, the respondents changed the rules by permitting the parties to submit documents after the last date. It is also contended that respondent No.6 now stands blacklisted. The petitioners have made a representation/ filed a complaint in this regard by their letter dated 20.04.2016( Annexure P7).

The petition is disposed of, with the following order:

If the work order has not been issued as yet, the same shall not be issued without considering and taking a decision on the said representation and serving a copy thereof upon the petitioners.

Further, in the event of the work order being issued, the work shall not commence for a period of seven days after the service of the decision of the official respondents upon the petitioners. The petitioners are always at liberty to challenge the decision if it is adverse. Needless to add that the official respondents would afford respondent No.6 also an opportunity of meeting the petitioners' representation/complaint.
