Ajay Tewari, J (Oral)

As per the report, amount of ₹ 20,000/- which was imposed as litigation expenses has been deposited. Let the same be released to respondents No.1 to 3.

In this appeal, the limited relief being sought by the appellant is that he is not in a position to deposit the entire compensation amount in lump sum but is ready to deposit the same in quarterly installment @ ₹ 1 lac along with upto date interest.

Counsel for respondents No.1 to 3 has accepted this offer.

In the circumstances, this appeal is allowed to the limited

extent mentioned above and it is directed that the appellant would be at liberty to deposit the compensation amount in three monthly installment of ₹ 1 lac till the entire compensation amount with upto date interest is paid. Counsel for the appellant states that the first installment shall be paid on or before 30.4.2016 and so on.
