Petitioner seeks the benefit of promotion, on account of the fact that the juniors have been promoted, as per the seniority list dated 31.12.2001.

It is not disputed that the petitioner retired on 31.01.2010 and he had approached the department vide representation dated 14.01.2016 (Annexure P2) and thus, now seeks consideration. In such circumstances, this Court does not feel that it is a fit case to exercise the extraordinary writ jurisdiction, under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, at this belated stage, since equal alternative and efficacious remedies are available to him.

Faced with this situation, counsel submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the present writ petition, in order to avail his alternative remedies, in accordance with law.

Ordered accordingly.
