Learned counsel for the appellant-revenue states that the tax effect involved in the present case is less than the monetary limit prescribed vide circular No.21/2015, dated 10.12.2015 issued by the C.B.D.T., New Delhi. He further submitted that keeping in view the aforesaid circular, the present appeal may be dismissed as withdrawn. However, liberty be granted to the revenue to file an application for revival of the appeal in case something survives therein.

2. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for. It is, however, clarified that withdrawal of the appeal by the revenue shall not be taken to be affirmation of order of the Tribunal on merits. Further, the legal issue as claimed by the revenue is being left open to be adjudicated in an appropriate case.
