When the order dated 08.05.2015 was not complied with and nobody appeared, the case was dismissed for non-prosecution on 05.08.2015. Thereafter, it was restored vide order dated 22.10.2016.

Learned proxy counsel seeks time on the ground that learned arguing counsel for the petitioner is in personal difficulty. However, he is not aware, as to why the order dated 08.05.2015 could not be complied with so far.

In view of the above, present writ petition is disposed of, with liberty to the petitioner to file fresh one, on the same cause of action but with better particulars and also complying with the order dated 08.05.2015 passed by this Court.
