The petitioners have assailed the order dated 04.01.2006 (Annexure P-5), whereby they have been relieved from service.

It is the case of the petitioners that they were working as Clerks with the respondent-University and the respondents after relieving them, issued e-tender notice for employing another set of contractual employees.

A co-ordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 26.05.2016 had held that no final decision with regard to employment on the basis of impugned tender notice be taken till the next date of hearing. The interim order had been continuing by various orders and remains in operation even today.

Learned counsel appearing for the respondent-University states that the cases of the petitioners for appointment on contractual basis would be considered before employing other contractual employees in

pursuance to the e-tender notice issued by the respondents. He further states that in case the petitioners are appointed, they would be treated as contractual employees of the University at par with those, who are being engaged on contractual basis in pursuance to the e-tender notice.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the respondent-University, this petition has been rendered infructuous and stands disposed of accordingly.
