S.J.VAZIFDAR, ACTING CHIEF JUSTICE (ORAL):

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent No.2 states that it has decided to withdraw the impugned order dated 19.04.2016. The impugned order terminating the petitioner's contract as well as blacklisting the petitioner, though two issues are inter-related.

2. He states that if the respondent No.2 decides to take any action against the petitioner a fresh show cause notice will be issued and the petitioner will be afforded an opportunity of being heard. The fresh show cause notice, if any, will be issued latest by 15.06.2016 and a fresh order, if any, shall be passed latest by 4.7.2016. The petitioner shall be given at least one week's notice to submit a reply and 72 hours' prior notice of any hearing.

3. The effect of the contract entered into with the private respondent i.e. respondent No.6 shall depend upon the fresh order that may be passed. In the event of no show cause notice having been issued or no order having been passed within the time stipulated above, liberty to the petitioner to apply in this writ petition itself for further reliefs regarding the contract.

4. The petition is accordingly disposed of by accepting the above statement.
