The petition has been filed for issuing suitable writ or direction, directing the respondents to take necessary steps for saving the lives of the general public from the stray cattle/bulls, who it is stated, are openly wandering on the National Highway No.10, State Highway and other link roads in various Districts of the State of Haryana including Districts Fatehabad, Sirsa and Hisar.

The writ petition filed is quite omnibus and it has not been specified as to which roads are affected. Besides, it is not shown as to whether the petitioner has approached the District Authorities and/or the Municipal Authorities for removal of the menace.

In these circumstances, learned counsel for the petitioner

prays that he may be allowed to withdraw the writ petition at this stage and file a fresh one after he first approaches the District Authorities and Municipal Authorities, concerned.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to file a fresh one.
