This petition was filed after CWP No.11548 of 2014 titled 'Mandir Mal Singh & others Vs. Punjab State Transmission Corporation Limited & others' was entertained by this Court and notice of motion issued to the respondents. The aforesaid writ petition was the main case in a bunch of writ petitions which were disposed of by common order dated 28.01.2016 passed in lead petition bearing CWP No.24317 of 2013 titled 'Vivek Dureja Vs. The Punjab State Transmission Corporation Limited & others' relegating the petitioners to their remedy before the Civil Court to resolve the disputed question of fact as to whether the bond signed by the petitioners was

based on threat or coercion or was otherwise unjust or had been acted upon willingly.

Learned counsel for the parties are ad idem that this petition, which is a straggler, has to be disposed of in the same terms as in *Vivek Dureja's* writ petition.

Accordingly, the present writ petition is disposed of in terms of the order passed in *Vivek Dureja's case*.
