Instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing impugned order/recommendation dated 10.09.2015 (Annexure P-7), whereby application for Arms Licence of petitioner has been rejected.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has filed an application for grant of Arms Licence under the provisions of Arms Act but inspite of laps of sufficient long time, no action has been taken. Learned counsel for the petitioner further contends that he will file representation/reminder to the competent authority i.e. Deputy Commissioner, Gurgaon. In case such a representation/letter is filed, the same shall be examined by the Deputy Commissioner, Gurgaon and decision shall be taken, in accordance with law, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and copy of the order so passed shall be communicated forthwith to the petitioner. In case the

decision has already been taken on the application for grant of arms licence, the same shall be conveyed to the petitioner immediately.
