The petitioners unconditionally give up their right to the allotment of Booth No. 2. They merely seek the refund of the amount deposited by them together with interest. It is not possible to consider the circumstances in which the petitioners have given up the allotment. In other words, it is not possible to consider in this petition whether it was on account of a default on the part of the petitioners or on the part of the respondents.

2. The petition is, therefore, disposed of by directing the respondents to consider and respond to the representation dated 26.03.2016 (Annexure P-7) by 31.07.2016.
