Primary challenge in this writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for setting aside order dated 02.02.2016 Annexure P3.

2. On the last date of hearing, learned State counsel had accepted notice and sought time to seek instructions.

3. A copy of the communication dated 12.05.2016 received from the Land Acquisition Officer, Urban Estate Department, Rohtak, produced by the learned State counsel, is taken on record. Copy thereof has been supplied to the learned counsel for the petitioner. The communication consisting speaking order passed therein reads thus:-

*“The speaking order passed in compliance of Hon'ble
Supreme Court of India order dated 24.02.2015 in Civil*

Appeal 653 of 2011 titled as Ravinder Vs. State of Haryana and further in compliance of Additional Director, Urban Estate, Haryana, Panchkula memo No.A-5-2015/11126-30 dated 19.11.2015, vide this office Endst. No.1338-43 dated 02.02.2016 is hereby withdrawn. The fresh order will be passed after affording an opportunity of being heard to the petitioner.”

4. It is submitted by learned State counsel that impugned order dated 02.02.2016 has since been withdrawn and fresh order shall be passed after affording an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner.

5. In view of the above, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous and stands disposed of accordingly. However, it is observed that the respondents shall pass fresh order in the aforesaid manner, preferably within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.
