Petitioner-Vandana Tuli was appointed as ETT Teacher vide order dated 15.04.2011 (**Annexure P-4**) on compassionate ground. Since she had not passed the Teachers Eligibility Test for the purpose of appointment as ETT Teachers as per the guidelines of NCT, a show cause notice dated 20.10.2014 (**Annexure P-8**) was issued, seeking to relocate the petitioner for compassionate appointment on Clerk or other Class-III post. Hence, the present petition seeking quashing the said show cause notice dated 20.10.2014 (**P-8**).

Upon notice, respondents have filed the reply wherein it is stated that since the Teachers Eligibility Test was conducted by the State of Punjab for the first time in the month of July 2011, therefore, the show cause notice issued to the petitioner was withdrawn vide order dated 27.04.2015, thus, learned State Counsel submits that the present petition has become infructuous.

In view of reply filed by the State, learned counsel for the petitioner concedes that the present petition has become infructuous.

Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed as infructuous.
