The petitioner has approached this Court under Articles 226/227 of Constitution of India for quashing a part of the impugned order dated 01.10.2015 (Annexure P5) to the extent of denial of interest of delayed payment of compensation.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner referred to award dated 01.10.2015 (Annexure P5) passed by the reference Court. Perusal of the award shows that Reference Court while deciding the reference under Section 30 of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894, has left the parties to seek their remedy for claim of interest before the appropriate forum.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner after arguing for sometime submitted that he may be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to file a detailed and comprehensive representation/claim before the appropriate authority. However, a direction be issued to the authorities to decide the same expeditiously.

4. Dismissed as withdrawn. It is, however, directed that in case any representation or claim is filed by the petitioner before appropriate forum, within a period of one month, the same shall be decided by the

concerned authorities expeditiously within a period of next 3 months in accordance with law after affording an opportunity of hearing to the concerned parties.
