RITU BAHRI, J.

Petitioners are seeking direction to the respondents to grant them the benefit of Contribution Pension Scheme dated 12.12.2006 with effect from their date of appointment i.e. 2006/2007.

With regard to their grievance, the petitioners made representations dated 01.04.2013, 10.05.2014 and 26.11.2015 (Annexure P-2, collectively).

Learned counsel for the petitioners has referred to the order dated 19.03.2013 passed by this Court in CWP No.5906 of 2013 titled as **Balwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and others** (Annexure P-4), wherein learned counsel for the petitioners had stated that a decision had been taken on 01.03.2013 by the Deputy Director, Department of Rural Development and Panchayats, Punjab to extend the benefit of Contributory Provident Fund from the date of appointment. Similar issue has come up

before this Court in **Ravi Kumar & others Vs. State of Punjab and others,**
CWP No.17800 of 2013, decided on 06.09.2013 (Annexure P-5), which was
disposed of in the same terms as in **Balwinder Singh's** case (supra).

At this stage, this petition is dispose of by giving a direction to
the respondents to look into the representations (Annexure P-2) and pass
appropriate orders in accordance with law in view of the judgments passed
by this Court in **Balwinder Singh and Ravi Kumar's** case (supra), within a
period of three months.
